Caring & Sharing Community Harvest

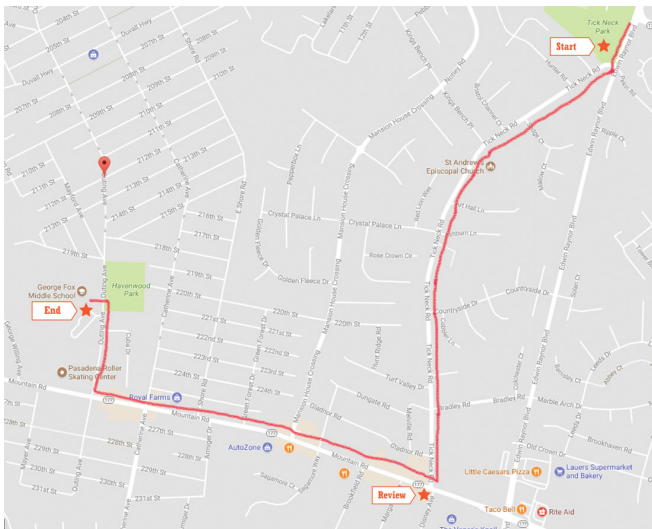

Parade Route:

Line up at Tick Neck Park, proceed to Tick Neck Road, Right on Mountain Road, Right on Outing Avenue, conclude at George Fox Middle School.

- Best Patriotic Entry
- Most Original and Judges Award (optional) will receive plaques
- Best Community Entry
- Best Youth Group Entry
- Best Musical or Performance Entry



Judging begins at 1:00 PM at Tick Neck Park and awards will be given out at the reviewing stand – Antiques to Go (Mountain & Tick Neck)

Each group/float will have 30 seconds at the reviewing stand.
