

Are you making the most from PBA Membership and Networking Opportunities?

Planning and setting realistic goals is the key to success in networking with fellow PBA members. Consider the following Tips for making every event count.

Get the Facts before the Meeting or Networking Event: Who might attend? Check the "registered attendees" list ahead of time on the PBA website. Is there someone attending that you want to get to know better? Planning ahead with the purpose of connecting with them is a great way to build business relationships.

Location, Location, Location: Although it's comfortable to sit with co-workers and people you know, Step out of your comfort zone by sitting with someone new for a more effective networking experience.

Don't Sell: Sales pitching is not networking. Practice your elevator speech (an Elevator Speech is a 30 second speech introducing yourself to get across a key point or two on your products or services). Be sure to give the other person the opportunity to give their "elevator speech" as well. After that, talk about something other than business.

Stock Your Tool Belt: Well, You don't have to actually wear a tool belt, but you will need a few things. Make sure you have plenty of business cards and wear a name tag. Many events will provide a "write-on" name tag if you don't have one. It's also a good idea to have a pen and a small notebook to make notes so you don't miss possible business opportunities. Some meetings will have an "Info Table" for flyers if you have something to share.

After the Event: Be sure to follow up with any prospects you met!!

Technology Class



When people search for businesses, the first thing that usually shows up in the results is the Google Maps results. We will go over not only the importance of being found here, but also ways to optimize your listing so you can show up in the map pack. The map pack is where 86% of people searching online go to find a local business.


