Website & Technology

Committee Update ~ November 2023

I want to thank all of those who attended the Artificial Intelligence (AI) workshop last month. It was a nice hour long Zoom webinar where we did an introduction to some basic AI tools that can be used in your business on a daily or weekly basis.

I am working on producing the video to distribute to those who registered and can make it available to our PBA members.

Thank you to Heidi Schmidt from Heidi Schmidt creative for co hosting the presentation and providing the recording for us to use.

Some of the tools we discussed were as follows. I went over some generative AI tools like ChatGPT (Free and Paid version for \$20 per month), Jasper that can be used to create website content as well as social media posts. Someone asked if ChatGpt could create a power point presentation. I had not used it like that before, but did a live experiment and ChatGPT created a 6 slide Power Point presentation. I did this with the paid version with a free slide generating plugin tool.

Heidi went into some details about the Al use in Canva for image generation and enhancement, providing us with some real time examples as well.

Heidi also talked about the importance of using the AI tools as a starting point for content generation. The generated content should be verified for accuracy and customized to match your brand style, tone and location.

They are great tools to use for brainstorming and creating ideas that can be used in many aspects of your business.

This wrapped up our workshop series for 2023. We look forward to hosting quarterly workshops in 2024 that will be designed to provide information and tools to help your businesses succeed. Alyssa, Heidi and I will start our planning for more incredible workshops for next year. Heck, we may even use some of the AI tools for our brainstorming sessions.....
